DRUG IGNORANCE

Not enough is being done to focus on the problems of drug-taking in the workplace, despite 70 per cent of drug users in Australia being employed, according to a drug screening specialist.

The claim comes ahead of Drug Action Week, being held from June 22 to 28 by the Alcohol and Other Drugs Council of Australia.

Michael White, managing director of Frontline Diagnostics, said "despite this, most organisations have no drug-safe program and, in many cases, are unaware of any drug and alcohol problem in their workplace".
